30	Withdrawal proposal verified	The Secretariat checked that the standard was normatively referenced in another ETSI deliverable. In such a case, the standard shall not be withdrawn unless a suitable solution for replacing the normative reference(s) has been found.
35	Withdrawal proposal TB approved	The responsible Technical Group approved the corresponding withdrawal proposal.
40	Start of Member Withdrawal Vote or Withdrawal Vote	This milestone marks the official launch of the period during which the ETSI members or the ETSI NSOs vote for 60 calendar-day period - based on predefined weights - on whether to approve, reject, and/or comment on an ETSI Standard (ES)/ETSI Guide (EG) or European Standard (EN). The ETSI members/ETSI NSOs have the duty to collect the comments and submit them to the ETSI Secretariat by electronic means. For further details on ES/EG withdrawal see clause 2.2.3.3 of the ETSI Technical Working Procedures (V51), or clause 2.2.1.3 for EN's withdrawal.
45	End of Member Withdrawal Vote or Withdrawal Vote	This milestones marks the end of the 'Member Withdrawal' or 'Withdrawal Vote' phase. The nature of comments submitted (if any) is checked as well as the results. See clause 13.5 of the ETSI Rules of Procedures (V51) for further details. The process can move forward based on the results.
50	Withdrawn	The Deliverable is marked as 'withdrawn' in the ETSI work programme but can still be downloaded.
